- Wests Leagues Club has a large Bistro where meals at a reasonable price can be obtained. There are also a number of specialty restaurants and three coffee shops where cakes, snacks including pizzas can be obtained throughout the weekend.
 - Direct access from Wests Executive Inn to the Starlight Room, Marble Bar and Terrace.
 - 350 park spaces with undercover access to the club and additional free parking close to the Clubs. A short walk to the New Lambton shops.
 - Public transport from Newcastle to the West Club is available. Ask for a timetable at the festival or see details on our website: www.newcastlejazz.com.au
 - Trains from Sydney stop at Broadmeadow Station. Catch a public bus which stops close to Wests or a cab (approx.\$15)
 - The bowling club is 200 metres from the main Wests Club entrance. If required a courtesy bus will be available to transport patrons to and from the Wests side entrance (Tauranga Rd) and the Bowling Club Greenhouse.
