NEWCASTLE BUSES

Keolis Downer now operate bus services in the Newcastle area.

Route 13 leaves Customs House, Watt St Newcastle and travels via Newcastle West, Hamilton and Broadmeadow to Alma Rd New Lambton (opposite the General Roberts Hotel). West's Tauranga Road entrance is 200m from the Hotel.

Route 23 bus leaves Marketown Shopping Centre, King St stop and travels to West's Hobart Road entrance. Current timetables are under review but can be found at www.newcastletransport.info/

USING PUBLIC TRANSPORT? YOU'LL NEED AN OPAL CARD.



OPAL card is available to holders of NSW and interstate Seniors Card holders for use on public Transport within the area.

You don't need a credit card to apply and there is no fee for a Gold Senior/Pensioner Opal card, however, you do need to add value to your Gold Senior/Pensioner Opal card to travel. You should only submit your application two weeks before you need to travel, as your application will be processed immediately and your card will only be valid for 60 days from the date of issue. If you need to travel in NSW for longer than 60 days, you will need to submit a new application when your card expires and a new card will be mailed to you.

TRAINS TO AND FROM NEWCASTLE

Trains to Newcastle now terminate at NEWCASTLE INTERCHANGE (Wickham/Newcastle West) and the LOOP Bus 110 transfers passenger to Newcastle's East End via Honeysuckle Drive. The shuttle bus only services 4 stops, Newcastle West, Newcastle Museum, Queens Wharf and Customs House Newcastle. 'Queen's Wharf' stop is in Wharf Road near the STOCKTON ferry terminal.

The LOOP 110 Bus returns to Newcastle Interchange via limited stops along King Street Newcastle.

BROADMEADOW STATION
